- Guide, coach & mentorship of direct reports and supervisors to oversee the training, supervising, evaluation and provide leadership for the department;
- Work closely with all departments to coordinate activities; with specific focus with the Mill Maintenance;
- Achievement of weekly, monthly, and quarterly mill performance targets;
- Mill operations and maintenance planning, including shutdowns and collaboration across the site;
- Contribute to the development of mill department budgets and forecasts;
- Ability to operate in a safe and responsible manner;
- Ability to effectively communicate with co-workers and supervisors;
- Other duties as assigned.
