



Medic/Health & Safety Coordinator

The company has an immediate opening for a **Medic/Health & Safety Coordinator**.

Position Overview:

Reporting to the Health & Safety Manager, the Medic/Health & Safety Coordinator will administer pre-hospital emergency medical care to patients with injuries or medical illnesses and transport them to medical facilities for further medical care when required. This position will also be responsible for the implementation and compliance of our Health & Safety program. The tasks associated with this include but are not limited to the development, improvement, implementation, and communication of the Company's health & safety strategy, initiatives, programs and policies. Coaching and mentoring of management, supervision and field staff on safe behaviors and risk identification through daily interactions and training sessions. Solid work ethics, regular attendance, and punctuality are essential requirements for this position. This will be a 14 day on / 14 day off rotation at our Keno Hill Project in Elsa, Yukon. This shift schedule is subject to change.

Primary Responsibilities:

- Assess extent of injuries or medical illnesses of patients to determine emergency medical treatment.
- Administer pre-hospital emergency care to patients such as oxygen therapy, cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), spinal immobilization, bandaging and splinting where required.
- Transport patients by land to medical facility for further medical care via onsite ambulance.
- Document and record nature of injuries and illnesses and treatment provided.
- Maintain emergency care equipment and supplies.
- Ensure compliance by all management, supervisors, and employees with Yukon regulatory and company requirements as they relate to the safe and healthy operation of the mine site.
- Perform planned inspections and risk assessments to identify and address unsafe conditions or hazards in the workplace.
- Identify health & safety concerns and hazards by surveying environmental, operational, and occupational conditions; investigate violations & recommend preventative programs.
- Lead incident investigations identifying root causes and assisting in the development of meaningful corrective actions.
- Ensure all safety equipment and tools are available and maintained in a ready to use condition.
- Participate in daily safety interactions and support the supervisors in the maintenance of surface & underground safety program including participation with safety meetings, workplace inspections, job observations, job hazard analysis, OHSC activities and incident investigations where required.
- Perform evaluation of best practices and approaches to the design and implementation of health & safety programs.
- Support and lead strategic health and safety improvement initiatives.

- Engage and support employee and contractor participation in health and safety programs and initiatives.
- Inform and educate employees and contractors concerning health and safety requirements, standards, etc.
- Facilitate safety training.

Education and Experience:

- 2 + years of First Aid experience, preferably within a mining or industrial setting.
- 5 + years of Health & Safety experience with a wide range of duties and increasing responsibilities.
- Preferably possess 3 + years of combined mining experience, of which 1+ years should be underground.
- Must possess at a minimum Advanced First Aid & CPR certification.
- Advanced skills with Microsoft Office Suite – Word, Excel, PowerPoint.
- Proven communications skills and ability to work as a team player.
- Pre-employment testing will be mandatory (drug/alcohol, lead blood, audiogram, etc.).
