



MILL SUPERINTENDENT

Overview:

Reporting to the Mill Manager, the Mill Superintendent is responsible to oversee the effective milling of ore and direct all mill activities. This will be a 15 day on / 13 day off rotation at our Keno Hill Project in Elsa, Yukon.

Key Responsibilities:

- To manage the day to day operations of the Mill in a safe manner;
- To analyze milling data and provide direction in the development of mill plans;
- To work with the Mill Manager in establishing the overall strategy for the mill;
- Ensure all Mill related projects are on time, and on budget;
- Develop and direct the implementation of operational programs, processes and policies to meet organizational governance requirements and standards;
- Provide expert advice throughout the site on mill processes and practices;
- Identify options and implement actions to adopt best practices for mill production;
- Supervise Mill team, manage by example, train, provide guidance and mentor in order to ensure the team reach its maximum potential;
- Assume all responsibilities of the Mill Manager in their absence
- Ability to operate in a safe and responsible manner;
- Other duties as assigned.
