OVERVIEW

Reporting to the Manager of Mine, your primary responsibility will be to provide underground operations support with electrical requirements.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Support underground mine electrical needs, in compliance with Federal and Yukon Electrical Codes & related regulatory / safety requirements;
- Ensure Federal / Yukon Electrical Codes and related Regulations remain in compliance;
- Installation, troubleshooting and repair of low, medium and high voltage circuits;
- Installation, troubleshooting and repair of A/C motors and variable speed drives;
- Programming, installation and maintenance of PLC's and HMI systems;
- Electrical maintenance as required on all milling and mining equipment;
- Provide direction, support and guidance to Apprentices as required; and
- Work cooperatively as a member of the Maintenance Team.

REQUIREMENTS

- 5 years related experience as a Journeyman Electrician;
- Interprovincial Journeyman ticket;
- Experience working in a remote mining or industrial environment;
- Ability to develop and foster strong working relationships;
- Valid driver's license;
- Physically fit to perform the duties of the position.
- Pre-employment testing will be mandatory (drug/alcohol, lead blood, audiogram, etc.)
