- Test and calibrate instruments for heat, pressure, volume, flow rates, and PH factors;
- Experience with safely maintaining, calibrating, installing, testing and troubleshooting pneumatic, electric, electronic, instrumentation devices;
- Advise operations and maintenance departments on status, condition, and known issues of equipment that could affect/improve their ability to achieve production goals;
- Solid understanding of electrical fundamentals and willingness to work with and support the electricians on site;
- Perform all instrumentation process control maintenance duties required. Equipment includes, but not limited to Emerson/Rosemount, Allen Bradley;
- Working with management to provide suggestions for future plant upgrades;
- Maintain and upgrade Mill HMI;
- Perform other duties as assigned.
