RESPONSIBILITIES

- Collect and perform QA/QC testing on shotcrete and cemented rockfill (CRF)
- Conduct pull testing on installed rock bolts that is in accordance with company and regulatory requirements
- Ensure adequate geotechnical instrumentation is deployed, read, maintained, and data reported
- Maintain database of all testing records
- Conduct weekly ventilation surveys and identify problem areas to ensure adequate ventilation is achieved and maintained
- Update and issue development and production driving layouts
- Assist with drill and blast design for longhole stoping blocks
- Generate weekly production schedules and reports
- Assist with surface and underground surveying duties
- Assist in developing Standard Operating Procedures (SOP's)
- Other duties as assigned
